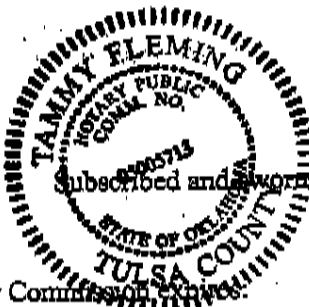

JOURNAL ENTRY OF DEFAULT JUDGMENT DELLY HOWE SMITH, COURT CLERK

NOW on this 30 day of August, 2006, this matter comes before the Court for entry of default judgment in favor of the Plaintiff, American Foreclosure Specialists, and against the Defendant, Neteffects1 Multimedia Design Firm. The Court, having reviewed the court file herein and otherwise being fully advised in the premises, finds that Plaintiff filed its Petition on April 26, 2006.

The Court further finds that the Plaintiff attempted personal service on the Defendant, at 8803 Twin Oaks Ct., San Antonio, Texas 78250, by using a sheriff's deputy with the Sheriff's Office of Bexar County, Texas, Jimmy Willborn Constable, who attempted to serve upon the Defendant a copy of the filed Petition and Summons however, personal service could not be accomplished, as evidence by the Officers' Non-Executed Return filed herein on August 14, 2006.

The Court further finds that the Plaintiff attempted personal service on the Defendant, at 8181 Tezel Rd, Box #102186, San Antonio, Texas 78250, by using a sheriff's deputy with the

Sheriff's Office of Bexar County, Texas, Jimmy Willborn Constable, who attempted to serve upon the Defendant a copy of the filed Petition and Summons however, personal service could not be accomplished, as evidence by the Officers' Non-Executed Return filed herein on August 14, 2006.

The Court further finds that Plaintiff obtained service on Defendant by mailing a copy of the Petition and Summons by certified mail, to the Defendant at: 8181 Tezel Road, Box #102186, San Antonio, Texas 78250, as evidence by the Certificate of Service by Mail filed herein on August 25, 2006.

The Court further finds that Defendant has failed to file an Answer herein or to otherwise enter a plea in this case.

The Court further finds that service of process on the Defendant was made in accordance with the applicable statutes of the State of Oklahoma and was in accord with both federal and state due process.

The Court further finds that the Defendant's Answer to Plaintiff's Petition was due on or before August 21, 2006. The Court further finds that said Defendant has failed to file an Answer herein or to otherwise enter a plea in this case. The Court finds that the Defendant is in default and the allegations of Plaintiff's Petition should be taken as true and established in this action and that the Plaintiff is entitled to judgment on said Petition.

IT IS THEREFORE ORDERED, ADJUDGED AND DECREED that the Plaintiff, American Foreclosure Specialists, have and recover Judgment against the Defendant, Neteffects1 Multimedia Design Firm, in the principal sum of \$7,800.00, with post-judgment interest thereon at the rate of

7.25% per annum (\$.97 per diem), pursuant to OKLA. STAT. ANN., Title 12 §727, from the date of the filing of this action until said judgment has been paid in full, plus all costs of collecting the judgment, plus a reasonable attorney fee in the amount of \$1,125.00 and costs of the action in the amount of \$329.75 for filing fees, service fees and costs, for a total judgment in the amount of \$9,257.75.
